Murray Sauer, who knows the area and the people really well took me (Don) to drive through the area and it was quite an eye-opener to see where crops were sown that came to nothing. With ongoing costs and the cost of living for these households, they will get nothing from their farms until next harvest.

Our choir is not charging, nor are the guest artists, nor the church, so that all the income from this concert will be shared between these households. Even if you are not keen on male voice singing, could you come and fill the audience so that these people can be helped. Admission will be \$15 with children under 15 free.
