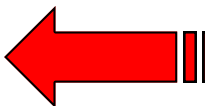

SOLO COMPETITION

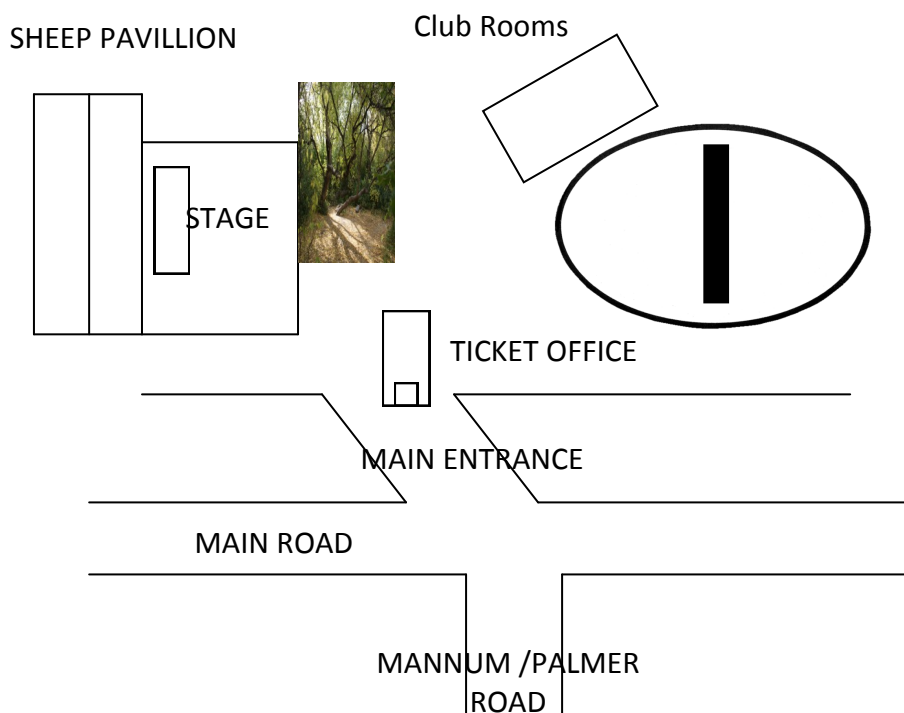
