The first slogan headed **Behaviour** Control your own behavior, Help others, Use the time we have wisely, Switch on and keep up. The second **Tone Quality** Project your sound, Produce a clear sound, Not too heavy, not too light, Good breathing to support voice. The Third **Presentation** Keep your eyes on the conductor, Show your "singing face" Stand tall, hands by your sides, SMILE! The fourth **Part Work** Be a confident alto or Soprano, Know your part well, Listen to the others around you, keep the parts balanced. The fifth **Interpretation** Excellent use of dynamics, use expression in your voice, understand the musical style. The sixth **Accuracy** Listen to those around you, Make sure you are on pitch, Give the correct notes and rhythm, PRACTICE!
I know we do not have any altos or sopranos, but the equivalent for us could be Tenors and Bases, do apply to any choir. Any reminders are good for all of us as we strive to give of our best at every performance.
